Improve muscle strength with less stress on the body

Blood Flow Restriction Therapy (BFRT) is limited occlusion of arterial and venous blood flow by applying a tourniquet to the upper or lower extremity during movement. It helps with skeletal muscle adaptation, systemic body changes, and cardiovascular benefits when applied at rest, with low intensity endurance exercises, or low load resistance training, allowing for improved muscle strength and aerobic capacity with less stress on the body. BFRT can help in most scenarios where a patient needs to preserve or improve strength, but is unable to tolerate the heavy loads required for traditional strength training due to pain or postoperative status.

BFRT has been widely adopted in recent years by major medical systems, professional sports teams, and countless physical therapists. The volume of research on BFRT has grown significantly over the past decade, as the US military began to experiment with BFRT as treatment for soldiers injured in Afghanistan and Iraq and in 2018, the American Physical Therapy Association declared that BFRT is part of the professional scope of practice for physical therapists.

Common post-operative conditions where BFRT can be applied include recovery of ACL reconstruction, total joint replacement, achilles repair, meniscectomy, and rotator cuff repair. Indications for non-operative application of BFRT include sprains, osteoarthritis, presurgical strengthening, and generalized atrophy or muscle weakness.
